

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
HELD AT SCOTT CITY HALL
THURSDAY, July 2, 2020 AT 6:00 PM**

The City Council Members met in Regular Session, Thursday, July 2, 2020, all Councilmen were present, Councilman Bergeron presided over the meeting.

Councilman Hollier led the Prayer and Pledge.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to accept the minutes from the June 4, 2020 meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion approved by majority.

Councilman Suire motioned to accept the minutes from the Special Meeting of June 24, 2020 meeting as written. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion approved by majority.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to accept the May 2020 Financial Statement. Seconded by Councilman Suire, motion approved by majority.

Ms. Ana Doucet with Fenstermaker & Assoc. reported that plans for Apollo Road Phase 2 and 3 are being submitted to DOTD this week and the utility relocation is moving forward. Construction began on the L8C Provost Pond on June 29, 2020. Engineering contracts from the State should be advertised before the end of September for the St. Mary St. Sidewalk and the LA 93-I-10 to Renaud Widening projects. Mr. Mark Savoy with Groom's Engineering reported that the sewer extension on Benoit Patin will begin in the upcoming month. The blacktop overlay project will begin in the next 3-4 weeks and take up to 75 working days to complete. Also, the drainage outfall pipes project was completed \$27,000 under budget.

Mrs. Kay Karre' Gautreaux asked for support for the upcoming November 3, 2020 election for District Judge.

Councilman Bergeron gave an update on the Census 2020.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Ordinance 2020-13, an Ordinance amending Chapter 40 (Land Use Code) to amend the definition for manufacturing, artisan, to permit manufacturing, artisan, automobile/vehicle dealerships and automobile rental establishments only in the T-5 and industrial land use districts and to amend the corridor standards applicable to the Apollo Road Corridor District (ARCD). No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2020-22, a Resolution adopting a Drainage Improvement Plan for the City of Scott. No discussion. However it was stated that the plan was presented to the Mayor and Council

in January 2020 by Fenstermaker and Associates. Seconded by Councilman Hollier, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Montoucet motioned to adopt Resolution 2020-18, a Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an act of donation (BCJ Boudreaux Family Farms, LLC.) Mr. Mark Savoy stated that the purpose was to accept the five-acre donation with future intentions to create a detention pond. Seconded by Councilman Boudreaux, motion carried by majority.

Councilman Suire motioned to adopt Resolution 2020-20, a Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a servitude agreement between the City of Scott and Ronald Albarado, et al. No discussion. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried by majority.


Councilman Suire led a discussion regarding the speed limits in the City of Scott in the Westwinds and Emerald Garden subdivisions. Councilman Suire stated that reducing the speed limit from 25mph to 15 mph will provide safer streets due to the increase speeding. Chief Chad Leger mentioned that stop signs might be more effort than speed bumps and/or reducing speed limits. Councilman Bergeron spoke in favor to reducing the speed limits. No action taken.

Councilman Boudreaux motioned to adopt Resolution 2020-21, a Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a servitude agreement between the City of Scott and Kampground of Scott, Inc. Mr. Mark Savoy, with Groom's Engineering stated that KOA Campground is donating easements to extend sewer to Billy's Boudin, Legends, and Ronald Albarado. KOA already has sewer services. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried by majority.

Ordinance 2020-17, introduced by Councilman Hollier. An Ordinance amending the City of Scott Land Use map, which will be up for adoption at the next regular council meeting August 6, 2020 at 6pm. The Ordinance will also be presented to the Planning Commission on July 21st, at 5:30pm. No discussion.

Councilman Suire motioned to grant a variance to the noise Ordinance Section 14-27 (C) (5), construction activity, Friday, July 3, 2020 from 5am to 7an between 1009 and 1011 St. Mary St. to property owner Mr. Anthony Hebert. The construction activity will not impede traffic. Seconded by Councilman Montoucet, motion carried by majority.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 6:35pm.
